The failed attempt to judicially review Sandwell by the subject member for abuse of process is also worth reading as it covers issues such as whether things done prior to the Localism Act could be investigated under the Act, whether a 'pre-investigation' amounted to prejudice and whether an investigator was entitled to make a finding or simply present the evidence and leave the conclusion to the committee | http://bit.ly/2DtjaXr |
| Honiton Town Council and East Devon District Council | A successful JR of an unlawful sanction imposed by a town council. However, the district council was found to have acted lawfully when it dealt with the case under the Localism Act | http://bit.ly/2n4MsFb |
