Brief Summary of Residents objections

- Noise nuisance particularly in the early hours of the morning and anti social behaviour from patrons leaving the premises
- People swearing shouting arguing urinating in the streets and slamming car doors when leaving premises
- Property prices in the area decreasing – residents unable to sell their property
- Large delivery wagons causing disruption to traffic flow and damage to resident's cars
- Vandalism and damage to property
- Broken glass and bottles litter the area particularly at weekend
- Noise from beer garden as late as 10.45 p.m.
- Marked decline the area since The Premier opened

Brief Summary of Business objections

- Extended hours would create serious public nuisance noise and disturbance from both inside and outside the premises.
- Danger of crime and disorder with late night revellers disturbing local residents
- There would be littler vandalism, noise from car doors and car engines and people unable to hold the food/drink they have consumed.
