- Drinking outside shall cease at 22.00 hours and patrons shall return into the pub
- All activities specified within part E - Live Music G- Performance of a Dance H – Anything Similar I – Making music J – Dancing shall cease at 23.00 hours
- Sale of alcohol shall be permitted until 2.00 a.m. hours and the premises shall close at 02.30 hours New Years Day
- Sale of alcohol shall be permitted until 00.30 hrs and the premises shall close at 01.00 hours on Christmas Eve and Boxing Day
- On the Friday and Saturday of a bank holiday weekend the hours of operation and licensing shall correspond with those agreed at other times (except New Years Boxing Day and Christmas Eve.)
