- Noise from any regulated entertainment (categories E & F) shall be inaudible at the nearest noise sensitive property between 01.00 & 02.00 Friday and Saturday
- The use of any outside area will cease at 23.20.
- Regulated entertainment as specified in categories E & F and for the sale of alcohol shall be permitted between the hours of 10.00 & 02.00 Friday and Saturday.
- The premises shall remain open to the public for no more than 30 minutes following the cessation of the regulated entertainment and the service of alcohol on Friday & Saturday.
