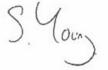

Notice is hereby given that under Regulation 5 of the above, Councillor Gilligan, as Chair of the Corporate Policy and Performance Board, has agreed to the following item of business being considered in Part II, as the item of business is considered urgent and cannot reasonable be deferred for the reason stated below:

REASON: Given the Council's financial pressures, a Transformation Programme is being developed to a very tight timescale, to enable it to be designed and approved as part of the 2022/23 budget setting process. The additional resources required to support this process are required immediately given the timescales involved and require approval at the earliest opportunity.
