3.1 The Apprenticeship Support by Be More Team, managed by Halton Borough Council, is funded by the European Social Fund (ESF) and the Strategic Investment Fund (SIF) to deliver career inspiration and guidance to Liverpool City Region (LCR) residents, and promote the take up of apprenticeships, vocational training and employment vacancies. Since the last report submitted in January the team have delivered a LCR Skills Show on the 1st and 2nd March 2022 to 2568 individuals, in addition to career events, educational theatre plays and 121 interventions.
