Wild NIHL team gave their play off hopes a boost with a highly important 3-5 win away at Nottingham Lions on Saturday.

The first period played out well for the Wild and it remained goalless until Nottingham finally broke the deadlock with the opening goal in the 28th minute.

Four minutes later, the score was 2-0 to the Lions and it seemed as if the Wild could be in trouble. However, they rallied from this and a goal late in the second period from Bailey Thompson kept Widnes in contention, as the score stood at 2-1 at the end of the second interval.

Nottingham edged further ahead on 45 minutes but a goal from Ben McLellan 10 seconds later reduced the deficit back to just one goal.

Widnes were on a roll by the time Luke Alston fired in a realising goal on 49 minutes. McLellan received a heavy challenge for his trouble. McLellan stuck up for his team and was subsequently sent from the game for a foul to the head on the Nottingham defender.

Wild dug deep and managed to weather the ensuing 5 minute powerplay and Daniel Thompson fired them into the lead for the first time in the game with a goal on 56 minutes.

Nottingham withdrew their players in favour of an extra period in the hope of salvaging something from the game. Bailey Thompson scored an extra goal with 59 seconds on the clock to seal the win for Widnes.
