SUBJECT: School Balances 2024-25

WARD(S) Borough wide

1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To report to the Schools' Forum the level of Revenue and Devolved Formula Capital (DFC) funding brought forward from 2024-25 by Halton Maintained Schools.

2.0 RECOMMENDATION: That

- 2.1 The report is noted.
- 2.2 That the Schools' Forum decides if any schools are to provide further information regarding their high Revenue Surplus balance.

3.0 SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 3.1 While balances are still required to be reported to the Schools' Forum, no excess surplus balance limits are currently in place. However, the Schools' Forum retains the right to require schools to provide further information as to how their balance will be spent should they so decide.
- 3.2 In accordance with statutory requirements, including the Schools Financial Value Standard (SFVS), schools are expected to sustain 'reasonable' levels of surplus balances and demonstrate 'Value for Money' through effective plans for spending their budgets.
- 3.3 Despite the excess surplus thresholds no longer being a mandatory consideration to the controls on surplus balances provision, the original maximum recommended thresholds are still commonly referred to, including by Ofsted, at 5% for Secondary and 8% for Nursery, Primary, and Special schools.
- 3.4 **Appendix A** shows the Revenue balances for each Maintained school, along with their 2023-24 balance for comparison.
- 3.5 The overall net surplus School Budget balances position for Halton maintained schools at the end of 2024-25 is £6,192,994.

- 3.6 Out of 44 Maintained schools, there are 36 (82%) with Surplus balances and 8 (18%) with a Deficit position at the end of 2024-25.
- 3.7 Of the 36 with surplus balances, 24 (representing 55% of all Maintained schools) have accumulated surplus balances above the original maximum thresholds of 5% and 8%. The schools above the maximum thresholds are highlighted in blue at Appendix A.
- 3. **Appendix B** shows the Devolved Formula Capital (DFC) balances for each Maintained school, along with their 2024-25 balance for comparison.
- 3.11 The balance of DFC for maintained schools has decreased by £50,975 to £240,097 at the end of 2024-25. This decrease is due in the main to the utilisation of additional capital funding to support schools with energy efficiency initiatives and developments.

4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 It is noted that, despite the many costs pressures being faced by schools, the overall school balances have been sustained at over £6m. The number of schools reporting deficit positions at 31 March 2025 has increased from the previous by to 2 to 8 overall.
